





Looking for a book, a magazine, an article or an e-book? Need resources for a project or a study? Want to have a place to study? You are welcome at the HU-Library (HUB)!

Digital sources

The HUB website offers you access to a vast amount of scientific literature, even from home. When you open a resource a login screen will appear. You can log in with your HU account (your email address @ student.hu.nl and password).

Thousands of magazines are digitally available via the website. Many magazines and other scientific sources are brought together in databases. Use them to search simultaneously in many sources.

You will find the databases most relevant for your discipline at the subject areas.

You also have access to a large and rapidly growing number of e-books. Use your HU account to read them at home.



LUCAS

LUCAS is our own search engine. It allows you to search multiple databases and the HUB catalog at once so you have access to a large part of the digital collection.

Borrow materials

You can borrow books from the library for four weeks. After those four weeks you can renew them. The books entitled "Dagleen" cannot be renewed and you have to return them the same day. A book that has been reserved by someone else, cannot be renewed.

Some materials, such as magazines and games, you can borrow for one week.

You always need your student card for borrowing.

When you are late to renew or return your books, you pay a fine of 25 cents per book per day (for "Dagleen" books the fine is 2 euros per day).

Search materials, reserve and renew

Using the search function in the catalog you can find all the books in the library. The e-books and paper journals are also listed in the catalog. The e-books can be opened directly through the catalog by clicking the link.

To know where to find a book on the shelf, look at the code at "Shelf mark" (for example: 003 VERH). To see if a book is available or on loan, click on "Availability of material".

You can reserve a book, for example when it is lent or at another HUB location.

When it is ready for you at the library desk you will get a message on your mail @ student.hu.nl.

You can renew through the catalog; you do not have to come to the library counter. Click on "Log in" at the catalog and use your HU account. You can now renew everything you have in your possession.

In the library you can study and work on a PC or your own laptop.
